What happens in Washington affects everyone. Credit unions like any organization are directly affected by federal legislation. To address this, it is necessary to periodically visit Washington to speak directly with our elected officials. Representatives of your credit union did just that on February 24th.

A member of your Board of Directors, Vijay Shah and I visited three members of the House of Representatives. We met with Con-

gresswoman Capito, Congressman Mollohan and Congressman Rahall. We discussed a number of important items, but our main topic dealt with the need to increase the current arbitrary cap on member business loans. The increase that is being sought would provide \$10 Billion to businesses within the first twelve months and would create as many as 108,000 jobs. Now, what is more important than jobs!

Please be sure to en-

courage members of the House and Senate to support the increase in member business lending. We thank our three House members for meeting with us. We had particularly positive meetings with Ms. Capito and Mr. Mollohan. Be sure to thank these individuals for supporting credit unions.
