## What is Android Pay?

Android Pay lets you pay for purchases with your Android device by holding your phone near a contactless reader. You can also use Android Pay to pay for purchases in participating apps.

## Which WV Central Credit Union card can I use with Android Pay?

You can add your WV Central Credit Union debit cards to Android Pay through the Android Pay app on your device.

## Are my payments safe with Android Pay?

Yes. Android Pay doesn't store your WV Central Credit Union card number on your phone or give it to the merchant. A unique digital code is created specifically for that device.

## When I add my WV Central Credit Union card to Android Pay, will it look exactly like the card in my wallet?

Yes, the image of the consumer debit card in the Android Pay app will look much like the card you carry.

You can use Android Pay at hundreds of thousands of stores, including Bloomingdale's®, Foot Locker®, Macy's®, Panera Bread®, Nike®, Staples®, Walgreens® and Whole Foods®.
